





Based on the scores, we can analyze the best browser for privacy and speed.

- 1. Speed: Brave leads with a score of 95%, making it the fastest browser among the options. Chrome follows closely with a score of 92%. Firefox and Microsoft Edge are tied at 82%, while Safari lags behind at 78%. Opera scores 80%, which is slightly better than Safari but still not as fast as the top contenders.
